**Bill Summary**

In the speedy trial statute, there is a list of time periods that are excluded from the speedy trial calculation. The bill adds the period of delay caused by a continuance granted by the court to the list, if the court finds that the continuance is necessary to protect the defendant's constitutional rights.

Capital letters or bold & italic numbers indicate new material to be added to existing statute.  
Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-1-405, **add** (6)(j)  
3 as follows:

4           **18-1-405. Speedy trial.** (6) In computing the time within which  
5 a defendant shall be brought to trial as provided in subsection (1) of this  
6 section, the following periods of time shall be excluded:

7           (j) THE PERIOD OF DELAY CAUSED BY A CONTINUANCE    ORDERED  
8 BY THE COURT,    IF THE COURT, IN ITS DISCRETION, FINDS THAT THE  
9 CONTINUANCE IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE DEFENDANT'S  
10 CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS.

11           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
12 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
