**Bill Topic:** REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PARK FEES SET BY RULE

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill removes obsolete references to statute that was repealed September 1, 2017, and has no fiscal impact on state or local government.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Review Committee.

**Summary of Legislation**

House Bill 12-1317, enacted the merger of Colorado Parks and Wildlife and repealed a section of statute effective September 1, 2017. This bill removes obsolete references to the repealed section and replaces them with references to the Parks and Wildlife Commission's rules.

**Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

Removing the obsolete references does not change the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state or local agency. Any workload associated with the original change in statute was accomplished with the implementation of HB12-1317.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 8, 2018, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 9, 2018, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
