**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$25,000 General Fund to the Youth Advisory Council Cash Fund for FY 2018-19. Please note that this cash fund is continuously appropriated in Section 2-2-1306, C.R.S., so an appropriation out of this cash fund to the Legislative Department is not necessary.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The general appropriations bill for FY 2018-19 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$25,000 for FY 2018-19, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
