These costs are not included in the Appropriation Summary on page 1 of the April 2, 2018, Fiscal Note.

**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$135,417 General Fund to the Department of Corrections' prison and parole costs for FY 2019-20 through FY 2022-23.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

This bill requires \$135,417 in statutory appropriations from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections from FY 2019-20 through FY 2022-23. These appropriations and transfers reduce the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
