Fiscal Impact of Bill as Amended to Date

Pursuant to Joint Rule 22(b), the Legislative Council Staff does not review bills limited to appropriations measures carrying specific dollar amounts for fiscal impacts. Section 1 of the bill appropriates a total of \$46,348,261 and 287.3 FTE for the Legislative Department for FY 2018-19. Section 2 of the bill provides a transfer of \$850,000 from the Preservation Grant Program Account of the State Historical Fund to the Legislative Department Cash Fund on October 1, 2018, to restore the Old Supreme Court Chamber of the State Capitol.
