**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision transferring \$11,256,561 General Fund to the Capital Construction Fund and appropriating a total of \$11,256,561 Capital Construction Fund to the Department of Corrections for FY 2018-19. The provision includes roll forward authority through FY 2020-21.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its budget package \$11,000,000 General Fund set-aside for FY 2018-19 for future prison capacity. This bill includes an appropriation to the Legislative Department for a legislative committee to study the state prison population.
