Summary of Legislation

In 2013, the American Psychiatric Association replaced the terminology related to "mental retardation" with the terms "intellectual disability" and "intellectual developmental disorder." This bill modernizes this terminology in state law.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

State agencies already use modern terminology, so modernizing the terminology in state law does not change the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state or local agency.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 21, 2018, and takes effect August 8, 2018, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
