Bill Topic: REPEAL PUBLISHING REQMNT DOR INCOME TAX RATE MODS

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill removes the requirement that the Department of Revenue (DOR) publish income tax rate modification history on every income tax return form. The bill aligns state statute with current practice.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: Signed into law.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes the requirement that the Department of Revenue publish income tax rate modification history on every income tax return form.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact because it aligns state statute with current practice, and therefore, has no effect on state or local government revenue, expenditures, or workload.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 12, 2018, and takes effect August 8, 2018, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
