**Bill Topic:** CSTARS ACCOUNT TRANSFER TO DRIVES ACCOUNT EFFECTIVE DATE

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** This bill established a uniform date of July 1, 2019, to transition the Department of Revenue's (DOR) CSTARS account to the new DRIVES Vehicle Services account. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Joint Budget Committee.

### Summary of Legislation

This bill establishes a uniform date of July 1, 2019, to transition the Department of Revenue's (DOR) CSTARS account to the new DRIVES Vehicle Services account. The bill also delays corresponding statutory repeal dates for one year.

### Background

A capital project is currently underway at the DMV in DOR to replace both the state's Driver License System and CSTARS with an updated computer system called DRIVES. The driver license portion of DRIVES came online February 2017. The portion that replaces CSTARS is scheduled to come online August 2018. Under House Bill 17-1107, 33 percent of the CSTARS account fund balance must be transferred to the DRIVES Vehicle Services account by September 1, 2018, with the remainder transferred by June 30, 2019.

### Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

As this bill only the changes statutory dates to transfer funds between the CSTARS account to the DRIVES Vehicle Services account, it will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of any state agency. As such, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

### Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
