Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Under current law, a medical marijuana patient is limited to having one primary caregiver at a time. The bill makes an exception for a patient who is under 18 years of age and allows each parent or guardian to serve as a primary caregiver.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-106, **amend**
3 (8)(b) as follows:

4 **25-1.5-106. Medical marijuana program - powers and duties**
5 **of state health agency - rules - medical review board - medical**
6 **marijuana program cash fund - subaccount - created - "Ethan's**
7 **Law" - repeal. (8) Patient - primary caregiver relationship. (b) (I) A**
8 patient ~~shall~~ MAY have only one primary caregiver at any given time;
9 EXCEPT THAT A PATIENT WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE MAY
10 HAVE EACH PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO ACT AS A PRIMARY CAREGIVER OR,
11 IF THE PATIENT IS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE JUVENILE COURT, THE
12 JUDGE PRESIDING OVER THE CASE MAY DETERMINE WHO IS THE PRIMARY
13 CAREGIVER.

17 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 takes effect December 1, 2020; except that, if a referendum petition is
19 filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against
20 this act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period
21 after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item,
22 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the
23 general election to be held in November 2020 and, in such case, will take
24 effect December 1, 2020, or on the date of the official declaration of the
25 vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later. ==
