- 101 CONCERNING THE ABILITY OF ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSES WITH
- 102 **PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY TO OBTAIN LEVEL I ACCREDITATION**
- 103 UNDER THE "WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT OF COLORADO".

Bill Summary

The bill allows an advanced practice nurse with prescriptive authority to obtain level I accreditation under the "Workers' Compensation Act of Colorado".

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-42-101, amend 3 (3.5)(a)(I)(A) as follows:

4 8-42-101. Employer must furnish medical aid - approval of 5 plan - fee schedule - contracting for treatment - no recovery from 6 employee - medical treatment guidelines - accreditation of physicians 7 and other medical providers rules repeal. 8 (3.5) (a) (I) (A) "Physician" means, for the purposes of the level I and 9 level II accreditation programs, a physician licensed under the "Colorado 10 Medical Practice Act", ARTICLE 36 OF TITLE 12. For the purposes of level 11 I accreditation only and not level II accreditation, "physician" means a 12 dentist licensed under the "Dental Practice Act", article 35 of title 12; 13 C.R.S.; a podiatrist licensed under article 32 of title 12; C.R.S.; and a 14 chiropractor licensed under article 33 of title 12; C.R.S. AND AN 15 ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE WITH PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY PURSUANT 16 TO SECTION 12-38-111.6.

17 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 18 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 20 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a 21 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 22 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 23 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 24 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 25 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 26 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
