PUBLIC HOSPITAL BOARDS OF TRUSTEES **Bill Topic:**

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill makes changes to the statutes regulating public hospital **Fiscal Impact:**

boards of trustees. It will not impact the revenue or expenditures of the state or any

local government and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

This bill removes this restriction that not more than four of the seven trustees of a public hospital board may be residents of the city or town in which the associated hospital is located. The bill also clarifies that a hospital board may acquire real and personal property by lease only with the approval of the board of county commissioners with the exception of hospital boards that have designated their public hospital as a TABOR-exempt state enterprise.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill makes administrative changes to the composition of local government boards and clarifies approval authority related to real estate acquisition. As such, it will not impact the revenue or expenditures of the state or any local government and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
