**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$250,000 from the Colorado Telephone Users with Disabilities Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies' Public Utilities Commission for FY 2019-20. This amount is reappropriated to the Department of Education for the State Librarian to provide services through the Colorado Talking Book Library for persons who are blind or physically disabled.

**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared technical amendment **J.001** (attached) to rename the line items receiving funds in the existing appropriation clause to names that more clearly identify the purpose of the line items. This amendment does not have a fiscal impact on the bill.
