The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$9,693,205 General Fund to the Judicial Department for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 78.0 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2019-20 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$9,693,205 for FY 2019-20, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs. In FY 2020-21, the bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$8,622,476, which will also reduced the amount of General Fund available for other programs.
