The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$40,056 cash funds from the P.O.S.T. Board Cash Fund to the Department of Law in FY 2019-20. The provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.6 FTE to implement the act.
