Summary of Legislation

This bill removes the requirement that the State Board of Health approve retention of counsel when either the Department of Public Health and Environment or any county or district board of health become involved in a legal action.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill removes an obsolete statutory provision. It will not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on February 20, 2019, and it takes effect August 2, 2019, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
