### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$396,604 from the Marijuana Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.8 FTE.
