Bill Topic: CLARIFY RADIATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE COMPENSATION

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill clarifies statutory language allowing members of the Radiation Advisory Committee to be compensated for their actual and necessary expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee

Summary of Legislation

This bill clarifies statutory language allowing members of the Radiation Advisory Committee in the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to be compensated for their actual and necessary expenses and corrects a reference in statute where the committee is referred to as "the board".

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Correcting these statutory references does not require any operational changes by the CDPHE or the Board. Therefore, it will not impact the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state agency or local government, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
