REPEAL CANCER DRUG REPOSITORY ACT Bill Topic:

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill removes language from statute concerning the state

Fiscal Impact: cancer drug repository program. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory

Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals a section of statute that establishes a state cancer drug repository program.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

A broader drug repository program for all types of unused medication exists in Title 12, making this limited provision obsolete. The bill is not expected to impact the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state agency or local government, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
