Bill Topic: EXEMPT CDE FROM OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill codifies the existing relationship between the Governor's Office of Information Technology and the Department of Education, and it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill clarifies that the Department of Education (CDE) is not considered a state agency for the purposes of Governor's Office of Information Technology (OIT) information technology services. However, the Chief Information Officer of OIT may enter into contracts with CDE for the purposes of providing disaster recovery services.

Background and Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

CDE and OIT currently operate under a memorandum of understanding for certain IT services. This codification of an existing practice will result in no change to state revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 23, 2019, and takes effect August 2, 2019, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
