### **Bill Summary**

**Sunset Process - House Energy and Environment Committee.** The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory

agencies' sunset review and report concerning the Colorado kids outdoors advisory council by repealing the council.

l	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
3	(10)(a)(I) as follows:
4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
5	declaration - definition - repeal. (10) (a) The following statutory
6	authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July
7	1, 2020:
8	(I) The Colorado kids outdoors advisory council created in section
9	<del>24-33-109.5, C.R.S.;</del>
10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33-109.5, amend
11	(5); and <b>repeal</b> (1)(a) and (4) as follows:
12	24-33-109.5. Colorado kids outdoors grant program - created
13	- fund created - rules - report - definitions - repeal. (1) As used in this
14	section, unless the context otherwise requires:
15	(a) "Advisory council" means the Colorado kids outdoors advisory
16	council created in subsection (4) of this section.
17	(4) (a) There is hereby created the Colorado kids outdoors
18	advisory council to assist the executive director in implementing the grant
19	program. The advisory council shall consist of six members as follows:
20	(I) The following ex officio members or their designees:
21	(A) The executive director of the department of public health and
22	environment;
23	(B) The commissioner of education;
24	(C) The executive director of the great outdoors Colorado

1	(D) The director of the division of parks and wildlife in the
2	department of natural resources; and
3	(E) (Deleted by amendment, L. 2011, (SB 11-208), ch. 293, p.
4	1389, § 13, effective July 1, 2011.)
5	(II) Two persons with expertise in outdoor recreation and
6	environmental education, one of whom is appointed by the executive
7	director of the department of natural resources and one of whom is
8	appointed by the commissioner of education.
9	(b) The appointed members of the advisory council shall serve
10	voluntarily and without reimbursement for expenses. Each appointed
11	member shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority and for a
12	two-year term. If a vacancy arises in an appointed position, the
13	appropriate appointing authority shall appoint a person who meets the
14	criteria specified in subparagraph (II) of paragraph (a) of this subsection
15	(4) to fill the vacancy.
16	(c) The advisory council shall have the following duties:
17	(I) To review grant applications received by the office of the
18	executive director and make recommendations to the executive director
19	for grant awards;
20	(II) To assist the executive director in establishing the criteria for
21	awarding grants through the grant program; and
22	(III) To otherwise advise the executive director concerning
23	implementation of the grant program.
24	(d) This subsection (4) is repealed, effective July 1, 2020. Prior to
25	said repeal, the advisory council shall be reviewed as provided in section
26	<del>2-3-1203, C.R.S.</del>
27	(5) An eligible entity that seeks a grant through the grant program

shall submit an application to the office of the executive director in accordance with rules promulgated by the executive director. Subject to the availability of funding, the executive director shall select grant recipients, specifying the amount to be awarded, taking into account the recommendations of the advisory council and the criteria established in rule.

SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
