02	THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY CAPITAL ACCOUNT WITHIN
03	THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$7,466,648 from the general fund to the information technology capital account within the capital construction fund on April 1, 2020.

I	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302, amend
3	(2.3) introductory portion, (2.3)(f), and (2.3)(g); and add (2.3)(h) as
4	follows:
5	24-75-302. Capital construction fund - capital assessment fees
6	- calculation - information technology capital account. (2.3) In
7	addition to the sums transferred pursuant to subsections (2) and (2.5) of
8	this section, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as
9	specified in this subsection (2.3) from the general fund to the information
10	technology capital account created in subsection (3.7) of this section as
11	enacted by House Bill 15-1266, as money becomes available in the
12	general fund during the fiscal year beginning on July 1 of the fiscal year
13	in which the transfer is made OR ON APRIL 1 OF THE FISCAL YEAR IF
14	OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. Transfers between funds pursuant to this
15	subsection (2.3) are not appropriations subject to the limitations of section
16	24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to this subsection (2.3) are
17	as follows:
18	(f) On July 1, 2018, fifteen million two hundred six thousand
19	seven hundred sixty dollars; and
20	(g) On July 1, 2019, twelve million three hundred forty-two
21	thousand six hundred seventy-six dollars; AND
22	(h) On April 1, 2020, seven million four hundred sixty-six
23	THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT DOLLARS.
24	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
25	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
26	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
