A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING A TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO**
102 **THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY CAPITAL ACCOUNT WITHIN**
103 **THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND.**

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$7,466,648 from the general fund to the information technology capital account within the capital construction fund on April 1, 2020.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-302, **amend**
3 (2.3) introductory portion, (2.3)(f), and (2.3)(g); and **add** (2.3)(h) as
4 follows:

5 **24-75-302. Capital construction fund - capital assessment fees**
6 **- calculation - information technology capital account.** (2.3) In
7 addition to the sums transferred pursuant to subsections (2) and (2.5) of
8 this section, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer a sum as
9 specified in this subsection (2.3) from the general fund to the information
10 technology capital account created in subsection (3.7) of this section ~~as~~
11 ~~enacted by House Bill 15-1266~~, as money becomes available in the
12 general fund during the fiscal year beginning on July 1 of the fiscal year
13 in which the transfer is made OR ON APRIL 1 OF THE FISCAL YEAR IF
14 OTHERWISE SPECIFIED. Transfers between funds pursuant to this
15 subsection (2.3) are not appropriations subject to the limitations of section
16 24-75-201.1. The amounts transferred pursuant to this subsection (2.3) are
17 as follows:

18 (f) On July 1, 2018, fifteen million two hundred six thousand
19 seven hundred sixty dollars; ~~and~~

20 (g) On July 1, 2019, twelve million three hundred forty-two
21 thousand six hundred seventy-six dollars; AND

22 (h) ON APRIL 1, 2020, SEVEN MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX
23 THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT DOLLARS.

24 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
25 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
26 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
