**Bill Topic:** NONSUBSTANTIVE REORGANIZATION DENTAL PRACTICE ACT

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** This bill is reorganizes and makes nonsubstantive changes to the Dental Practice Act. This bill has been assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local government.

## Summary of Legislation

This bill reorganizes the Dental Practice Act in Title 12 and makes other nonsubstantive changes.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill reorganizes the Dental Practice Act and does not make substantive changes. As a result, the bill will not affect the revenues or expenditures of any state or local agency and has been assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 23, 2020, and takes effect on September 14, 2020, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
