Description of Amendments in This Packet L.008/J.001

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.008** (attached) requires the Division of Criminal Justice in the Department of Public Safety to research existing tracking systems with secure electronic access. This reduces the fiscal impact to \$44,200.

If sponsor amendment **L.008** is adopted, staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$44,200 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2020-21.

J.002

Staff has prepared amendment **J.002** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$104,560 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2020-21 consistent with the fiscal note. The provision also appropriates a total of \$60,360 reappropriated funds from the Department of Public Safety to the Office of the Governor.

If the committee adopts amendment L.008, amendment J.001 should be adopted. If the committee does not adopt amendment L.008, amendment J.002 should be adopted.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2020-21. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$104,560 for FY 2020-21, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2020-21 appropriations by this amount.
