**Bill Topic:** **HOUSING MENTORS IN YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FACILITY**

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** This bill allows the Department of Corrections to house mentors in a youthful offender facility when certain conditions are met. It will not impact state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill allows offenders involved in a mentorship program with youthful offenders to be housed in a youthful offender facility when certain conditions are met.

## State Expenditures

The bill allows the Department of Corrections (DOC) to move certain offender populations from one DOC facility to another. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
