Bill Topic: **HOUSING MENTORS IN YOUTHFUL OFFENDER FACILITY**

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill would have allowed the Department of Corrections to house mentors in a youthful offender facility if certain conditions were met. The bill would not have impacted state or local revenue or expenditures and was assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation was required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the reengrossed bill. This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

The bill allows offenders involved in a mentorship program with youthful offenders to be housed in a youthful offender facility when certain conditions are met and so long as the offender has not been convicted of a sex offense

State Expenditures

The bill allows the Department of Corrections (DOC) to move certain offender populations from one DOC facility to another. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Judiciary Committee on May 26, 2020.
