Summary of Legislation

The bill authorizes the Medical Services Board in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing to adopt rules for the Children's Habilitation Residential Program to implement changes proposed in a waiver submitted to the federal government, provided that the rules are not effective until the waiver is approved.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

By allowing rules to be adopted in advance of anticipated waiver approvals, the bill affects only the timing of rulemaking. It will not affect state or local revenue or expenditures, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Public Health Care and Human Services Committee on May 27, 2020.
