Summary of Legislation

Currently, the Department of Personnel and Administration (DPA) manages a display space at the Colorado Convention Center to be used by counties, municipalities, state agencies, and private organizations to promote tourism, education, business, and agricultural activities in Colorado. The bill transfers management of the display space from DPA to the Office of Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT), and authorizes OEDIT to convene an advisory group to help manage the display space.

State Expenditures

In FY 2020-21, the bill increases workload in OEDIT to establish a stakeholder advisory group to help manage the display space. This workload is expected to be minimal and no appropriation is required.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
