Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies in its sunset review of the Colorado special education fiscal advisory committee by continuing the committee indefinitely.

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-20-114.5, **amend**

6 **subsection (2) is repealed, effective September 1, 2021 2031. Before its**
7 **repeal, the committee is scheduled for review in accordance with section**
8 **2-3-1203. C.R.S.**

9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
10 **(12)(a)(IV); and add (22)** as follows:

11 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**
12 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (12) (a) The following statutory
13 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on
14 September 1, 2021:
