A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING ALLOWING COMPENSATION FOR A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION BY WRITTEN RESOLUTION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

The bill removes the restriction on compensation for a president or vice-president of a school district board of education (board) and allows for the compensation of members of a board. The bill also clarifies that any modification to compensation cannot occur during an officer's or member's term in office. The bill also requires that a board set compensation rates for officers and members by written resolution. The

bill also allows members of a board to be reimbursed for necessary expenses in amounts approved by a majority vote of the board.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-32-104, amend 3 (5) as follows: 4 22-32-104. Organization of board of education. (5) The 5 secretary, assistant secretary, treasurer, and assistant treasurer OFFICERS 6 AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT may 7 be compensated for their services in such capacities in an amount 8 determined by WRITTEN RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF 9 the board; of education, but the president and vice-president shall receive 10 no compensation for their services in such capacities EXCEPT THAT NO 11 OFFICER OR MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY HAVE HIS OR HER COMPENSATION 12 INCREASED OR DECREASED DURING THE TERM IN OFFICE TO WHICH HE OR 13 SHE HAS BEEN ELECTED OR APPOINTED. All officers AND MEMBERS OF THE 14 BOARD shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the 15 performance of their duties in an official capacity IN AMOUNTS APPROVED 16 BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD. 17 **SECTION 2.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 19 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
