1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-805, **add** (4)
2 as follows:

3 **24-34-805. Family preservation safeguards for families that**
4 **include a parent with a disability - protections - short title - legislative**
5 **declaration - definitions.** (4) THE SHORT TITLE OF THIS SECTION IS THE
6 "CARRIE ANN LUCAS PARENTAL RIGHTS FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES
7 ACT".

8 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
9 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
10 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
11 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
12 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
13 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
14 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
15 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
16 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
