Bill Summary

The bill transfers \$30 million from the general fund to the state highway fund to provide additional funding for the department of transportation's revitalizing main streets and safer main streets programs.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:





SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-219, add (6)
 as follows:

24-75-219. Transfers - transportation - capital construction definitions - repeal. (6) ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION
(6), THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THIRTY MILLION DOLLARS
FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE PURPOSE
OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE REVITALIZING MAIN STREETS
AND SAFER MAIN STREETS PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
