A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS**
102 **FROM THE MARIJUANA TAX CASH FUND TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL**
103 **CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ASSISTANCE FUND, AND, IN**
104 **CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. On June 1, 2022, the state treasurer is required to transfer \$100 million from the marijuana tax cash fund to the public school capital construction assistance fund (BEST fund).

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-43.7-104, **add**
3 (2)(g) as follows:

4 **22-43.7-104. Public school capital construction assistance fund**
5 **- creation - crediting of money to fund - use of fund - emergency**
6 **reserve - creation - reserve account - creation and use.** (2) (g) THE
7 ASSISTANCE FUND INCLUDES ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS, WHICH THE
8 STATE TREASURER IS REQUIRED TO TRANSFER FROM THE MARIJUANA TAX
9 CASH FUND CREATED IN SECTION 39-28.8-501 (1) ON JUNE 1, 2022,
10 PURSUANT TO SECTION 39-28.8-501 (4.8).

11 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-28.8-501, **add**
12 (4.8) as follows:

13 **39-28.8-501. Marijuana tax cash fund - creation - distribution**
14 **- legislative declaration - repeal.** (4.8) ON JUNE 1, 2022, THE STATE
15 TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE
16 FUND TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ASSISTANCE FUND
17 CREATED IN SECTION 22-43.7-104.

18 **SECTION 3. Appropriation.** For the 2021-22 state fiscal year,
19 \$100,000,000 is appropriated to the department of education. This
20 appropriation is from the public school capital construction assistance
21 fund created in section 22-43.7-104 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the
22 department may use this appropriation for public school capital
23 construction assistance board cash grants.

24 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
