**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2020-21 or FY 2021-22.

**Points to Consider**

*General Fund Impact*

The fiscal note indicates that the FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 cost of H.B. 21-1003 is \$75,561 and \$21,087 General Fund, respectively. This cost is based on the assumption that Legislative Council Staff will require an additional 1.1 FTE in FY 2020-21 and 0.4 FTE in FY 2021-22 to implement the bill. Legislative Council Staff and Joint Budget Committee Staff agree that no appropriation is necessary, as sufficient vacancy savings exists within the current appropriation to cover the cost of the bill.
