The bill replaces the term “illegal alien” with “worker without authorization” in public contracts for services. The bill will increase workload for state and local agencies in FY 2021-22 only.

Summary of Legislation

This bill replaces the term “illegal alien” with “worker without authorization” in public contracts for services.

State Expenditures

The bill will increase workload for state agencies to update contract templates and forms for future contracts in FY 2021-22 only. This increase in workload can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Local Government, School Districts, and Special Districts

Like the state, local governments will have an increase in workload to update contract templates and forms for future contracts. This increase is expected to be minimal.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 15, 2021, and takes effect on September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
