**Bill Topic:** **AURICULAR ACUDETUX PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE**

---

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** The bill clarifies that a practitioner does not have to be licensed, certified, or registered to perform auricular acudetox. It does not change the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government.

---

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

---

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

## Summary of Legislation

House Bill 20-1206 repealed the requirement that a practitioner be licensed, certified, or registered as a mental health professional to perform auricular acudetox. This bill makes a conforming amendment consistent with that bill.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

As the bill conforms inconsistent sections of statute, it does not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government agency.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
