Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill clarifies that a practitioner does not have to be licensed, certified, or registered to perform auricular acudetox. It does not change the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

House Bill 20-1206 repealed the requirement that a practitioner be licensed, certified, or registered as a mental health professional to perform auricular acudetox. This bill makes a conforming amendment consistent with that bill.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

As the bill conforms inconsistent sections of statute, it does not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government agency.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
