## Summary of Legislation

The bill permits an inbound active duty military member to use the school liaison office address for the military installation where the member will be assigned to apply for open enrollment in a public school. If an active member is certified mission essential and must live on a military installation, school districts or charter schools must enroll the member's child with a guaranteed enrollment slot of the member's choice. Once the child of an inbound active member is open enrolled, schools must guarantee enrollment while the child remains at the school, and give preference for younger siblings enrolling in subsequent school years.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

While the bill may modify school enrollment policies, the bill is not expected to impact overall enrollment, revenue, or expenditures for school districts, charter schools, or other local education providers. Thus, it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
