Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment J.001 (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of

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\$104,780 to the Department of Agriculture for FY 2021-22, including \$52,390 cash funds from Industrial Hemp Registration Program Cash Fund and \$52,390 cash funds from Marijuana Tax Cash Fund, while reappropriating \$21,268 to the Department of Law. The provision also appropriates \$279,194 cash funds from the Marijuana Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2021-22, while reappropriating \$31,902 to the Department of Law. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Agriculture will require an additional 0.7 FTE, the Department of Revenue will require an additional 1.9 FTE, and the Department of Law will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

Points to Consider

Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$20.4 million available for appropriation or transfer from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, based on that revenue forecast. This bill requires an appropriation/transfer of \$52,390 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2021-22, reducing the anticipated balance by the same amount.
