Bill Topic: REMOVE JUNIOR FROM CERTAIN COLLEGE NAMES

Summary of Fiscal Impact: State Revenue TABOR Refund
 State Expenditure Local Government
 State Transfer Statutory Public Entity

The bill removes the word junior from the names of two colleges. The bill increases workload for the two colleges and the community college system in FY 2021-22 only.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill changes the names of the following colleges:

- Trinidad State Junior College to Trinidad State College; and
- Otero Junior College to Otero College.

State Expenditures

In FY 2021-22, the bill increases workload and costs for the community college system and the two colleges to update forms, websites, and other materials with the new names. Any costs are expected to be minimal and will be covered with institutional funds or donations. No change in state appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 18, 2021, and takes effect on September 7, 2021, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
