## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$5.0 million General Fund to the Department of Local Affairs in FY 2021-22 for REDI grants, and allows unexpended funds to be used in 2022-23 for the same purpose.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$5.0 million General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
