The bill allows boards of county commissioners to require registration of businesses in unincorporated parts of the county. The bill may increase local expenditures on an ongoing basis.

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**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

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## Summary of Legislation

The bill gives a local board of county commissioners the authority to register businesses in the unincorporated portions of the county. However, the bill does not grant a board of commissioners the power to license or collect a fee for such registrations.

## Local Government

Starting in FY 2021-22, when a county requires business registration in unincorporated areas, administrative and legal costs will increase.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
