Bill Topic: SIPA COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION METHOD

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill authorizes the Statewide Internet Portal Authority to use additional competitive procurement methods to contract with a statewide portal

integrator. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Joint Technology

Committee.

Summary of Legislation

Current law prohibits the Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) from entering into a contract with a statewide portal integrator unless the statewide portal integrator was chosen pursuant to a Request for Proposals (RFP) process. The bill authorizes SIPA to use other competitive procurement methods.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill allows SIPA, a statutory public entity outside the state budget, additional procurement flexibility. It will not impact state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
