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**Bill Topic:** SIPA COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION METHOD

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**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** The bill authorizes the Statewide Internet Portal Authority to use additional competitive procurement methods to contract with a statewide portal integrator. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

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**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

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**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Joint Technology Committee.

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## Summary of Legislation

Current law prohibits the Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) from entering into a contract with a statewide portal integrator unless the statewide portal integrator was chosen pursuant to a Request for Proposals (RFP) process. The bill authorizes SIPA to use other competitive procurement methods.

## Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill allows SIPA, a statutory public entity outside the state budget, additional procurement flexibility. It will not impact state or local revenue or expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
