AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR DISABILITY BENEFITS UNDER THE "LAURA HERSHEY DISABILITY SUPPORT ACT", AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATION CONTAINED IN THE 2020 SUNSET REPORT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 24-30-2212 as follows:

24-30-2212. Sunset review - repeal of part. (1) This part 22 is repealed, effective September 1, ~~2021~~ 2026.

~~(2) Prior to such repeal, the department of regulatory agencies shall review the assistance program for disability benefits as provided for in section 24-34-104~~
BEFORE THE REPEAL, THIS PART 22 IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-34-104.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal** (21)(a)(I); and **add** (27)(a)(XVIII) as follows:

24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative declaration - repeal.
(21) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will repeal on September 1, 2021:

~~(I) The assistance program for disability benefits under part 22 of article 30 of this title;~~

(27) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2026:

(XVIII) THE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR DISABILITY BENEFITS UNDER PART 22 OF ARTICLE 30 OF THIS TITLE 24.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act takes effect September 1, 2021.

SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
