**AN ACT****CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COUNCIL OF HIGHER EDUCATION REPRESENTATIVES.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-1-108.5, **amend** (3)(e) as follows:

**23-1-108.5. Duties and powers of the commission with regard to common course numbering system - definitions - repeal.** (3) (e) This subsection (3) is repealed, effective September 1, 2021. ~~Prior to such 2031. BEFORE THE repeal, the council of higher education representatives shall be reviewed as provided for IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW in ACCORDANCE WITH section 2-3-1203. C.R.S.~~

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (12)(a)(V); and **add** (22) as follows:

**2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative declaration - definition - repeal.** (12) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2021:

(V) ~~The council of higher education representatives convened pursuant to section 23-1-108.5 (3), C.R.S.;~~

(22) (a) THE FOLLOWING STATUTORY AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE DESIGNATED ADVISORY COMMITTEES WILL REPEAL ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2031:

(I) THE COUNCIL OF HIGHER EDUCATION REPRESENTATIVES CONVENED PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-1-108.5 (3).

(b) THIS SUBSECTION (22) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2033.

**SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect September 1, 2021.

**SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
