Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law requires the owner of a truck to present a manufacturer's certificate of origin or a certified scale ticket if the truck is subject to certain weight-based fees and weighs more than 4,500

pounds but not more than 10,000 pounds. This weight includes mounted equipment other than recreational equipment. The bill makes 2 changes to these requirements:

- The requirement only applies when the truck's weight has been substantially modified; and
- The truck must be weighed rather than using a manufacturer's certificate of origin to show shipping weight.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-304, amend 3 (17)(a) as follows: 4 42-3-304. Registration fees - passenger-mile taxes - clean 5 screen fund - pilot program - report - rules - definitions. (17) (a) At 6 the time of registration of such vehicle, the owner of a truck subject to 7 registration under section 42-3-306 (5) having a weight in excess of four 8 thousand five hundred pounds, but not in excess of ten thousand pounds, 9 including mounted equipment other than that of a recreational type, shall 10 present to the authorized agent a copy of the manufacturer's statement or 11 certificate of origin that specifies the shipping weight of such vehicle, or 12 if such documentation is not available, a certified scale ticket showing the 13 weight of such vehicle. THE OWNER SHALL PRESENT TO THE AUTHORIZED 14 AGENT A CERTIFIED SCALE TICKET SHOWING THE WEIGHT OF A TRUCK IF 15 THE TRUCK: 16 (I) IS SUBJECT TO THE REGISTRATION FEE IMPOSED IN SECTION 17 42-3-306 (5); 18 (II) WEIGHS MORE THAN FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS 19 BUT NOT MORE THAN TEN THOUSAND POUNDS; AND 20 (III) HAS BEEN MODIFIED, INCLUDING MOUNTING EQUIPMENT

OTHER THAN RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT, AND THE MODIFICATIONS

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -							
applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following							
the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the							
general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant							
to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an							
item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item,							
section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the							
general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take							
effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the							
governor.
