The bill requires schools that offer comprehensive human sexuality education to include a five-minute high-definition ultrasound video demonstration. It will increase school district expenditures beginning in FY 2022-23.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires schools that offer comprehensive human sexuality education to include a five-minute high-definition ultrasound video demonstration showing each stage of human development.

School Districts

School districts will incur costs to purchase the required video demonstration. Costs are unknown at this time and are likely to vary by school district.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
