The bill would have required schools offering comprehensive human sexuality education to include a five-minute high-definition ultrasound video demonstration. It would have increased school district expenditures beginning in FY 2022-23.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation was required.

Fiscal Note Status: The final fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires schools that offer comprehensive human sexuality education to include a five-minute high-definition ultrasound video demonstration showing each stage of human development.

School Districts

School districts will incur costs to purchase the required video demonstration. Costs are unknown at this time and are likely to vary by school district.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Health and Insurance Committee on March 16, 2022,.
